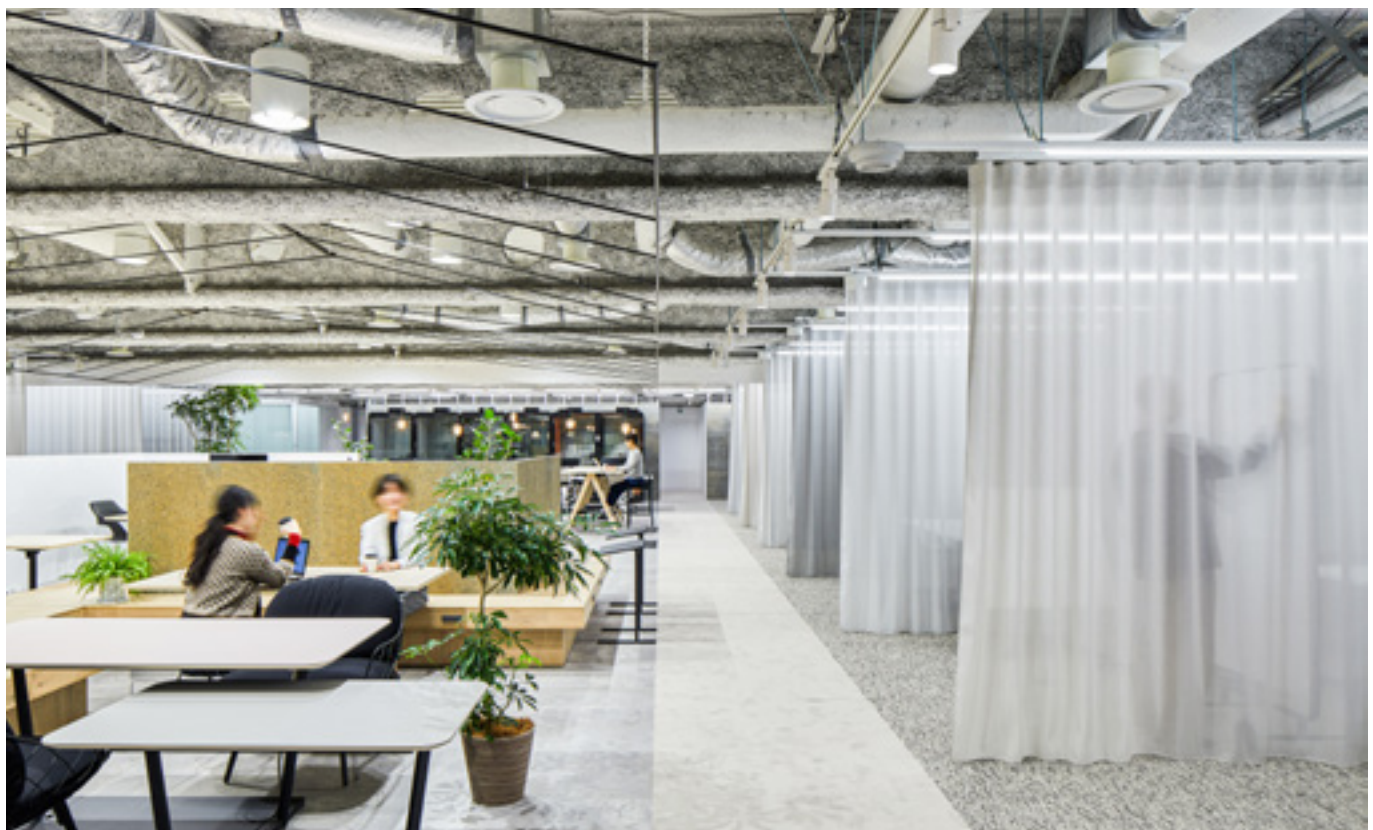

The solution: Control sound with textiles

Textiles are perfect for optimising acoustics. Thanks to Création Baumann's acoustic fabrics, the ambient sound can be controlled and made more pleasant. This is nice to hear, but also nice to see: with a wide range of sheer to opaque room textiles in numerous colours, the design possibilities are virtually limitless. In addition, functions such as blackout, flame retardancy, glare and heat protection are available.

Acoustics meet transparency: The innovation

Leading the way in innovation, Création Baumann is continuing to develop its acoustic fabrics. A few years ago, the Langenthal-based textile experts achieved what had been thought impossible: using a new thread and weaving technique to create a light, sheer, sound-absorbing acoustic fabric. This developed into a collection of transparent acoustic fabrics in Trevira CS, once again setting the tone for everyone else.

Acoustic curtains for zoning

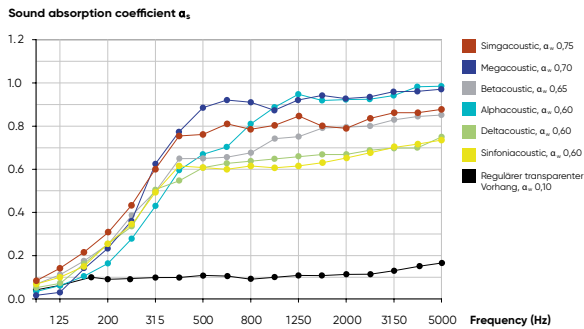

This can not only be heard, but also measured: The acoustic qualities are tested strictly according to ISO/EN standards in the reverberation chamber and precisely recorded. Transparent acoustic fabrics

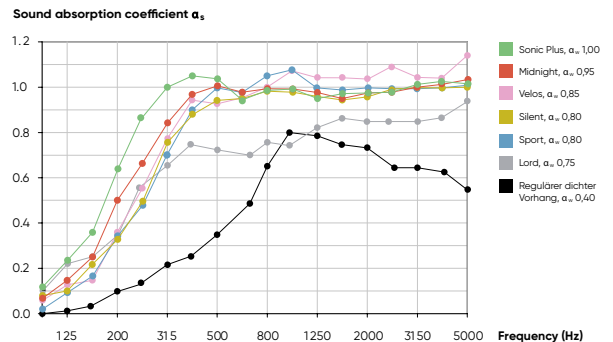
Sheer acoustic fabrics are ideal for places where ambiance and lighting are key.
